

## **Lagunitas School District Fund-raising Agreement 2011-2012**

### **Middle School, Montessori Program, Open Classroom, Waldorf-Inspired Program (WIP)**

- 1) Each elementary program shall hold one fund-raising event per school year. WIP may split their planned raffle from their event for 2011-2012 year only.<sup>1</sup> WIP will make every effort to ensure the timing of the event and the raffle do not conflict with other district-wide and program events, so as not to divert financial and volunteer resources from other events.
- 2) Middle School shall take action on its future plans for moving towards joint fund raising.
- 3) Raffle prize solicitation shall be limited to program parents, special local contacts (if happy to support another event in addition to LEAP's annual Valley Visions fund-raiser), and businesses well outside the local area. LEAP shall provide a copy of the Valley Visions donor list to each program. Programs are asked to not approach businesses on the Valley Visions donor list.
- 5) Each program may participate in the SGVCC Holiday Faire if it so wishes.
- 6) An annual joint meeting shall be held on May 14, 2012 (unless rescheduled by the LEAP president) to review the terms of the Fund-raising Agreement, reach agreement for the following school year, and set the calendar for the following school year's fundraising events.
